Advanced Search Techniques and Search Strategy Design for Systematic Reviews, Health Technology Assessment, and Guideline Development

Bern (Switzerland), University of Bern campus 27 February to 2nd March 2017

This 4-day course will address the challenges of designing advanced search strategies in large bibliographic databases using different conceptual combinations and search techniques. It will also introduce textual analytic and text mining techniques to demonstrate their potential for strategy design and testing.

Objectives:

The course will provide opportunities to learn new techniques, to discuss best approaches, to share insights and to assess variations in current best practice. The course will consist of short presentations, small group and plenary discussion and hand-on exercises.
