The Department 'Prevention and Evaluation', headed by Prof. Hajo Zeeb, is dedicated to three major thematic fields: i) health inequalities with specific reference to migration and gender, ii) innovative interventions for health promotion, with a main focus on digital public health, and (iii) evidence based public health.

Scientist (post doctoral level)

Tasks:

- Support the work of the Cochrane Public Health Europe Hub (CPHE)
- Collaborate with and support BIPS staff in evidence synthesis
- Develop and conduct own evidence reviews (topics: prevention, health promotion, eHealth, mHealth)
- Publish your research in peer-reviewed international journals and present research at conferences
- Develop a research agenda focussing on strengthening the evidence base for prevention aligned with the institute's long term research strategy and informed by the developments in CPHE.

Requirements:

- Master's and doctoral degree in epidemiology, public health or related disciplines
- Proven research track in systematic reviews and evidence synthesis
- Strong research orientation and quantitative skills
- Excellent scientific writing skills
- Excellent English language skills, ability to communicate in German

Desirable:

- International research and/or educational experience in epidemiology/public health
- Experience with grant writing
- Interest in Digital Public Health and/or implementation science

Access to existing data sets and to field sites will be provided as feasible. The institute supports postdoctoral development through mentoring, participation in conferences and training workshops, among others.
